- Nurture positive relationships
- Establish and teach expectations
- Acknowledge student success



EVIDENCE-BASED INTERVENTIONS

- Positively greeting students
 - Increases student engagement
 - Reduces disruptive behaviors
- Universal strategies include
 - Providing prompts and positive feedback
 - Interventions based on functional behavior assessment



CONSISTENT, COORDINATED & CLEAR COMMUNICATION

- Gets staff, students & parents on the same page
- Establishes shared expectations
- Sustains commitments



CONTINUUM OF SUPPORT

- Teaching & acknowledging expected behaviors to all students
- Providing supplemental supports as needed
- Applying intensive supports for students with highest needs



USE OF DATA

- Achieve healthier and more positive future for students
